

A special meeting of the City Commission was held in the Commission Room of the City-County building, 325 Court Street, Sault Ste. Marie, Michigan on Friday, June 3, 2011 at 7:30 a.m.

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Bosbous

Authorization of a Work Directive to Remove and Dispose of Petroleum/Gasoline Contaminated Soils in Bingham Avenue Between E. Portage Avenue and E. Maple Street:

On Tuesday afternoon of last week, a petroleum/gasoline odor was detected by Burton Excavating while excavating for the sanitary sewer on Bingham Avenue mid-block between Portage and Maple Street. The excavation and hauling was immediately halted and Mackinac Environmental Technologies was contracted to take samples of the material. The results of the analysis of the contaminated soils was completed as of Wednesday, June 1st, and arrangements have been made to haul the contaminated soils to the Waste Management landfill.

The total estimated cost of handling and disposing of 1,000 cubic yards of contaminated soil is as follows:

Material Handling and Hauling (Burton Excavating)	\$20,000
Landfill Disposal (Waste Management)	\$53,000
Consulting Services (Mackinac Environmental)	<u>\$ 5,000</u>
Total	\$78,000

That the City Commission authorize the handling and disposing of up to 1,000 cubic yards of contaminated material from the CSO C-1 and C-2 Division D project area in Bingham Avenue for a total estimated cost of \$78,000.
